KEY AREASOF INTERVENTION

HEALTHCARE

Providing affordable, quality healthcare through hospitals such as Al-Shifa Multispecialty Hospital and various clinics across India, helping millions of underserved people access affordable and quality medical services.

Established by HWT in 2011 in Jamia Nagar area of South East Delhi, Al-Shifa Multi-Specialty Hospital provides healthcare services at an affordable cost to underprivileged sections of the society.

Key Information Related to Al-Shifa (as of September 2024):

















Al-Shifa provides free dialysis services to patients in need, having completed a total of 64,000+ dialysis sessions so far.

MOBILE MEDICAL VAN

Al-Shifa operates a Mobile Medical Van that travels through various slum areas of Delhi. An MBBS doctor onboard provides free consultations and distributes medicines at no charge. The Mobile Medical Van has benefited over 1,00,000+ residents in the slum areas of Delhi.

COVID-19 SUPPORT

During second wave of Covid-19, HWT launched several initiatives to ensure immediate and affordable access to treatment for those affected by the virus. Key activities included:

- Established and run a temporary Covid Field Hospital at The Scholar School (Abul Fazal Enclave, Delhi) to treat Covid-infected patients.
- · Installed an Oxygen Generation Plant at Al-Shifa Multi-Specialty Hospital
- Donated a life-saving ACLS Force ambulance to Al-Shifa (Delhi) and an ambulance to Khidmat Welfare Trust (Lucknow)

HUNGER RELIEF

Distributing fresh cooked meals, food baskets / Ration kits to impoverished families, with a focus on widows, orphans, and slum dwellers.



Project Ehsas

Launched in 2021 under the Vision 2026 flagship project in Delhi, Kolkata and Lucknow to address the severe hunger crisis worsened by the Covid-19 lockdowns and subsequent job losses, HWT, through its Community Kitchens, has served over **3,50,000** freshly-cooked meals to slum dwellers, providing vital nourishment to the most vulnerable. The project continues to make a difference by providing over 500 fresh and hot meals daily to those in need in Delhi.



Food Kits

HWT is committed to fighting hunger by distributing essential Food Kits to those in need across the country, twice a year. With compassion at the heart of its mission, HWT has already delivered approximately 4,00,000 Food Kits, providing vital nourishment to countless families and individuals in need.



ORPHAN AND WIDOW CARE

Supporting widows and orphans through financial assistance, scholarships, medical check-ups, and counselling. HWT ensures that their basic needs including education are met while empowering them to build better futures.

(AS OF SEPTEMBER 2024)












ECONOMIC EMPOWERMENT

Helping poor and vulnerable families gain financial independence through selfemployment and livelihood support including establishment of small business units, provision of sewing machines, Auto Rikshaws, E-Rickshaws, Cycle and Vegetable Carts etc.

EDUCATION · · · · · · · · · · · · ·

HWT is dedicated to transforming lives through education, focusing on providing access to learning for children from impoverished and economically-backward communities. Through various educational projects including construction of schools, hostels, and school capacity building, HWT works to ensure that children who are deprived of basic education get the opportunity to learn and grow.

As of 2022, HWT has established a *Community Learning Centre (CLC)* in Shiv Vihar, North East Delhi, where school dropout rates are high. This Centre offers basic education to out-of-school children, preparing them for formal schooling.









WATER AND SANITATION

Addressing the critical clean drinking water shortage by installing Hand Pumps, Submersibles, and Open Wells in rural areas.

As of September 2024, HWT has completed below water projects across various states of India:









LOW COST HOUSING

Building safe, low-cost houses for families in need particularly those affected by flood, ensuring they have a secure roof over their heads.

As of September 2024, HWT has built approximately **100 low-cost houses** for poor and flood-affected people, and supported reconstruction and repair of around **35 houses** across various states in the country.
